Pennsylvania's Spring 2022 Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grades Announced

**Bethlehem, PA, May 10, 2022 –** The Leapfrog Group, a national nonprofit representing hundreds of the nation's most influential employers and purchasers of health care, driven in Pennsylvania by Lehigh Valley Business Coalition on Healthcare (LVBCH), announced today the <u>spring 2022 Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grades</u>.

The independent grading system assigns an "A," "B," "C," "D," or "F" grade to all general hospitals across the U.S. based on over 30 national performance measures reflecting errors, accidents, injuries, and infections, as well as systems hospitals have in place to prevent harm. LVBCH is your Regional Leader for The Leapfrog Group in Pennsylvania.

In Pennsylvania, 133 hospitals were graded, and 61 earned an "A," 39 earned a "B," 26 earned a "C," 7 earned a "D," and none earned an "F." Only one Pennsylvania hospital – St. Clair Hospital located in Pittsburg – has received 'Straight As' since 2013. Overall, Pennsylvania has 45.9% "A" Hospitals and ranks 10<sup>th</sup> in the Nation.

LVBCH would like to recognize our local hospital systems and their hospitals that received an "A" including: Geisinger's Geisinger Medical Center, Bloomsburg, and Lewistown, Shamokin, and St. Luke's hospitals; Lehigh Valley Health Network's Hazleton and Pocono hospitals; and St. Luke's University Health Network's Allentown, Anderson, Bethlehem, Miners, Monroe, Sacred Heart, and Upper Bucks hospitals.

"The Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grade provides hospitals and patients with the information they need to make informed choices on where they seek care in Pennsylvania," said Carl Seitz, LVBCH President. "We commend our hospitals in Pennsylvania who continue to ensure that the safety of the patients they serve comes first."

"Hospital safety is now more important than ever. A hospital's sustained commitment to patient safety and health care quality saves lives," said Amanda Greene, Director of Operations, LVBCH and Leapfrog Regional Leader. "By using the Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grade, patients and their families can make the best selection for where to seek care."

The Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grade is the only hospital ratings program based exclusively on hospital prevention of medical errors and harms to patients. The grading system is peer-reviewed, fully transparent and free to the public. Grades are updated twice annually, in the fall and spring.





"Patients in Pennsylvania deserve to know which hospitals are safest, so they can make an informed decision to protect themselves and their loved ones when seeking care," said Leah Binder, president and CEO of The Leapfrog Group.
