Dr. Burtaine is board certified in Occupational Medicine and began his career as a family doctor in Allentown, PA. He earned his bachelor's degree from the Johns Hopkins University and his medical degree at the College of Medicine and Dentistry, New Jersey. He completed his post-graduate work at Lehigh Valley Hospital.
